We are looking to hire visionary, creative physicians to impact the future of healthcare in a region which is underserved by osteopathic medicine. BCOM OMM faculty are responsible for designing and delivering an OMM curriculum which is integrated into the physical diagnosis/primary care and basic science spiral, systems-based curriculum with the goal of graduating students who will regularly utilize OMM in their practices.

Specific Faculty Responsibilities:

- Assisting with the development and presentation of OMM curriculum for years 1-4.
- Advising and mentoring students in academics and career development.
- Institutional service including serving on committees, participating in prospective student interviews, and representing BCOM in a positive and productive manner.
- Research and scholarly activity which includes participation in faculty development and meetings, maintaining professional literacy in academic field, working to create and add knowledge to specialty field, and supervision and mentorship of student research projects.
- Clinical practice responsibilities include working in the outpatient OMM clinic on the BCOM campus and possible inpatient opportunities at Mountain View Medical Center.

Minimum Qualifications:

- DO degree
- Board certification by the appropriate AOA or ACGME specialty board, as required.
- Ability to be fully licensed in New Mexico
- Skills necessary, and a desire, to work well as a member of a team which includes basic scientists and primary care physicians.

Preferred Qualifications:

- NMM/OMM or FP/OMT Board Certification
- COM or GME teaching experience
- Experience using innovative teaching methods which might include team-based learning, 'flipped classroom', problem-based learning, distance learning, interactive large group presentation, audience response systems, curriculum delivery systems (e.g. Blackboard), and proficiency in exam item writing (USMLE / COMLEX format).
- Experience with curricular and instructional design.

This full-time position has an immediate start date.

BCOM offers a competitive salary and benefits package, commensurate with appointed faculty rank, qualifications, and experience.

**NOTE TO APPLICANTS:** Applicants must currently be authorized to work in the United States on a full-time basis.
