



Research Related Injury

PURPOSE

This policy addresses the requirement for providing an explanation of whether any compensation and/or medical treatment are available should injury occur to a human research subject as a result of the study.

SCOPE

All BCOM Agents and Students involved in Human Subjects Research

RESPONSIBLE OFFICIAL(S)

Authorized Institutional Official for Research, Director of Research, Institutional Review Board

POLICY

Research Related Injury

Federal policy 45 CFR 46.116 states that: “For research involving more than minimal risk, an explanation as to whether any compensation and an explanation as to whether any medical treatments are available if injury occurs and, if so, what they consist of, or where further information may be obtained.”

The IRB requires that all consent forms for studies involving more than minimal risk contain the following specific language:

“If you are injured as a direct result of participation in this study, The Burrell College of Osteopathic Medicine will provide necessary medical treatment. The costs of the treatment may be billed to your insurance like any other medical costs. BCOM and/or the study sponsor will pay for any necessary medical costs related to the treatment of your injury due to your taking part in the study that are not paid by your insurance or any other payor. BCOM and the study sponsor do not provide for loss of wages or any other form of compensation for injury. Neither BCOM nor the study sponsor will cover injuries incurred as a result of travel to or from a location where the study is occurring, unless that travel is part of the study. You do not give up your legal rights by signing this form.
