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POLICY

The College prohibits the unlawful manufacture, distribution, dispensing, possession or use of a controlled substance at BCOM facilities.

RESPONSIBLE OFFICIAL(S):

Administration, Office of Human Resources, Office of Student Affairs

PROCEDURES:

1. Each year, the College will review its resources that are made available to students and employees. All students and employees will be provided notification of these resources on an annual basis. The notification shall include the health risks associated with abuse of illicit drugs or alcohol use, consequences of illicit drug and alcohol abuse violations on campus including local, state, and federal laws pertaining to violations, and a list of campus and community resources available for persons with alcohol or drug related problems.
2. Biennially, to comply with the Drug-Free Schools and Communities Act (DFSCA), a report will be prepared and submitted to the US Department of Education regarding the effectiveness of the College's drug and alcohol abuse prevention program and consistency in the enforcement of sanctions.
3. College employees and students are subject to appropriate disciplinary action for violation of this policy in accordance with College policies and procedures.
