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POLICY

BCOM will integrate osteopathic philosophy, principles and practices including didactic and hands-on opportunities into each academic year of the curriculum.

RESPONSIBLE OFFICIAL(S):

Associate Dean of Pre-Clinical Education, Associate Dean of Clinical Education, OMM Faculty

PROCEDURES:

1. BCOM shall identify the cognitive and psychomotor competencies unique to the practice of osteopathic manipulative medicine that must be acquired by all students through the four-year curriculum.
2. Learning opportunities for each of the several competencies identified in satisfaction of this procedure shall be assigned to each of the years of training as is appropriate for the level of student development. To the extent possible, training in osteopathic principles and manipulative medicine techniques shall be integrated into all course offerings although some dedicated training may be required.
3. The BCOM osteopathic curriculum shall include supervised clinical observation and practice.
4. BCOM shall monitor the success of its curriculum in osteopathic manipulative medicine through student performance on internal assessments and COMLEX Levels 1, 2 and 3.
5. The college shall review its curriculum in osteopathic manipulative medicine at least annually to assure compliance with this procedure and general attainment of student competence.
