- **Responsible Research Practices**
 - The Office of Research & Sponsored Programs wishes to remind researchers of responsibilities related to conduct of research.
 - All research involving human subjects must be reviewed and approved by the Burrell College Institutional Review Board (IRB) prior to data collection. Burrell College [SOP RSP.009](#) provides detailed information on Research Activities that Require IRB Review and Approval. The IRB meets monthly to review new protocols and can be contacted at IRB@bcomnm.org for additional information. Dr. Harald Stauss serves as IRB Chairperson.
 - All research involving biohazardous agents and recombinant DNA that is conducted in the College Research Laboratories must be reviewed and approved by the Burrell College Institutional Biosafety Committee (IBC). The IBC can be contacted at research@bcomnm.org for additional information. Dr. Michael Woods serves as IBC Chairperson.
 - Individuals wishing to publish case reports should consult the Burrell College SOP [RSP.001 Case Report Publication Guidance](#). IRB approval is typically not required for clinical case reports of three or fewer patients as long as criteria described in the SOP are met.
- **Time and Effort Reporting for Grants**
 - Time and effort reporting forms for investigators receiving salary support for grants will be sent out monthly beginning on November 1, 2020. We had previously sent these out quarterly. Please feel free to contact ORSP with questions.

 - The Secretary's Advisory Committee on Human Research Protections (SACHRP) will meet virtually October 20, 2020 from 11:00 – 4:30 Eastern Time. The topics to be discussed include the Interpretation of Public Health Authority and Public Health Surveillance Activities at 45 CFR 46.102(k) and 46.102 (I)(2), Justice as an Ethical Concept in 45 CFR part 46, and Considerations for Risks to Bystanders in Research.
