

## TITLE IX

Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972, [34 CFR Part §106.31](#), states the following:

*No person in the United States shall, on the basis of sex, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any education program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance.*

The College subscribes and adheres to the principles and requirements of Title IX and maintains such policies as are needed to assure the protection of its students under this statute. Anyone observing actions by students, faculty or staff of the College or anyone who believes they have been the object of such discrimination or any discriminatory practices by the College or its affiliates under Title IX should notify the Title IX Coordinator. Any allegation of violation under Title IX will be investigated. The reporting individual may file such reports anonymously and without fear of retaliation.
