



Gabor Szalai, PhD is an Associate Professor of Immunology in the Department of Biomedical Sciences at the Burrell College of Osteopathic Medicine in Las Cruces, New Mexico. He has earned his Ph.D. in 1995 after studying the horse MHC genes in Bern, Switzerland. He has moved to the US in 1999 and since received over 3 million US dollars in federal research funds. He has published his results in 39 peer-reviewed articles. He has taught immunology for over 10 years for BSc and MSc students and has been an immunology faculty in osteopathic medical schools for 4 years, joined Burrell in 2019. Dr. Szalai is a member of the American Association of Immunologists and served as NSF and NIH panelist.
