Dr. Guerrasio is a nationally and internationally known expert in the remediation of struggling medical learners. Her work on the development of individualized learning plans for struggling learners has impacted education across the health professions, including residents and fellows, as well as medical, nurse practitioner, physician assistant, physical therapy, occupational therapy and optometry school students. Dr. Guerrasio received her Doctor of Medicine degree at Albany Medical College and completed her Internal Medicine Internship and Residency at the University of Connecticut, Farmington. She became Professor of Medicine in the Department of Medicine, Division of Hospital Medicine, at the University of Colorado School of Medicine and served as the Director of Medical Student and Resident Remediation for almost 13 years. She has received many awards for excellence in medical education and is the author of *Remediation of the Struggling Medical Learner*, as well as numerous publications in major medical education journals.
