Sarah Marlow, RN, is the Executive Director of Hospice at Ambercare Hospice in Las Cruces, Deming, Silver City, Truth or Consequences, and Alamogordo NM. She also serves on the Las Cruces Palliative Care Coalition. She began her medical career in Temple, Texas completing the Critical Care Internship Program through American Association of Critical Care Nurses and then served as the Trauma Care Coordinator/Charge RN IV-SNT-ICU for Scott & White Memorial Hospital's Level 1 Trauma Center. While at Scott & White, she served on the Quality Committee developing one of the Nation's first Rapid Response Teams (RRTs) following the launch of the 100,000 Lives Campaign in 2004 by the Institute for Healthcare Improvement. In 2007 her family relocated to Baumholder, Germany due to military relocation and were stationed there for 7 years. She was appointed Deputy Chief of Nursing for the Baumholder Health Clinic through the European Regional Medical Command. In 2014, she returned to
