There were no students placed on a waiting list.</li> <li>43 student researchers have committed to the SRE opportunity and all 43 have been matched; 8 students did not commit, and 1 student never responded to communications.</li> <li>The faculty submitted 11 new proposals, while 8 projects were carried over from the previous year. Two projects will not continue. There are 17 faculty projects in all.
